Bujdosó winery is growing vines on the South shore of Lake Balaton in some of the most beautiful vineyards of the varied Somogy hills. Three generations work together to preserve and convey as much as possible of the natural aromas of grapes to our wines. Their motto is: "Our bottles are filled with the Balaton sunshine." There are four alumni of the Oenology faculty of the Horticultural University in the family: grandpa Feri who looks after the vineyards, grandma Klári the best teacher for the workers in the vineyards, Feri and his wife Bea the two winemakers. Starting from July 2013 Feri is the president of the Balatonboglár Winegrowers' Association. Zsiga the younger brother is also an active member of the business as Head of Sales. The third generation, four granddaughters and five grandsons also help out in the winery.

CIRKÁLÓ



The aroma of the wine is clearly dominated by ripe fruits such as peaches, peaches, and even mangoes. Vibrant acids make the sip firm, with peaches and ripe apples. A well-proportioned, lively wine that will quickly become a favorite.

Feind<u>.</u> Lake Balaton | Hungary<u>.</u>



In 1995 Lajos Feind founded our winery when he bought 14 hectares of grapes close to Lake Balaton. This is where the viticulture began, leading it in the direction of the winery. Within 20 years he expanded to 130 hectares of vineyards. Most of these can be found in Öreg-hegy in Balatonfőkajár, but also in Balatonvilágos, Balatonaliga and Balatonfüred, so all of the plantations are part of the Balatonfüred-Csopak wine region.

In January 2019 Lajos Feind handed over the management of the vinery to his son Zoltán Feind and his executive István Bacskai.

We work with 20 varieties of grapes, giving us a wide range of selection. The main direction of the winery - where we are our strongest -, is in aromatic white and rosé wines, but we also produce a nice range of red wines.

NOTES

Our orange wine was made from Rhine Riesling, fermented on the skins, aged in a 225 litre oak barrel for a year. This technology is native to Georgia, even to date their premium white wines are fermented on the skins with red wine technology. A rich wine, with a lingering taste. Perfectly matched with walnut, aubergine or lamb based dishes, but it is well worth trying with Asian cuisine too.

Our champagne is made from Sauvignon Blanc using the Charmat method. The Coupé Brut is lightly sparkling with bright acidity. With a complex taste and aroma, it's fruity notes are dominated by apple and pear. It is perfect as an aperitif and as an accompaniment to fish dishes.

Gilvesy Winery Lake Balaton | Hungary



Robert Gilvesy founded his winery in 2012, starting with older vineyards from the 1970s and then replanting others in 2015 with a focus on Olaszrizling, Furmint, Rhine Riesling and Sauvignon Blanc. Robert Gilvesy actually grew up on a small farm in Ontario Canada, but as second generation Hungarian, moved to Hungary in 1992. An architect by trade (his amazing home and cellar are testament to this) and familiar with doing business internationally, he decided to settle along the shores of Lake Balaton. Committing both to the science and magic of these volcanic terroirs, he is just getting started while also investing in other properties along the Balaton to start raising up the region as a whole. A true evangelist for all things Hungarian food and wine, Robert Gilvesy leads the association of Volcanic Wines in Hungary and hosts amazing food and wines events at the winery like the annual Bohém Légyott Festival.

Heimann<u>.</u> Szekszárd | Hungar<u>y.</u>



The style of the Heimann family's classic wines was developed by Ágnes and Zoltán Heimann. The first decade of the 21st century was dedicated to finding the special Heimann style: the family brought top quality cuttings of Cabernet Franc and Merlot from Bordeaux and planted them on the Porkoláb-völgy plateau. When in 2002-2003 the first monopole vineyard of the family, the 11ha Bati Kereszt was planted a significant acreage was dedicated to Viognier, the one and only white variety of the estate. The west facing slopes were planted with Tannat from Basque Country and Sagrantino from Umbria. These latter varieties give an individual touch to the character of the top of the range wines: Franciscus and Barbár. The goal is to produce wines that display full ripeness and refreshing fruit. This is the trademark of Szekszárd wines and Heimann wines too.

To honor this, the BEDOBA wine was created as a cooperation between Georgian winemaker Nugzar Ksovreli from the Kakheti wine company and Swiss winetrepreneur Thierry Fontannaz. The wine cellar in the Khaketian area dates back to 1533 when the winemaker of Kakhetian King Teimuraz II, Kakhaber Konchoshvili founded a wine cellar where the traditional Kakhetian wines were produced and sold.


